Columbia Heights Academy ~ The Keely Family Homeschool Curriculum Notes: Grade 6 (age 10±)

Our Plan: a neo-classical secular education based on the <u>Well-Trained Mind</u> but with a much stronger than suggested focus on STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics). Grades 5-8 are the logic years so we approach our lessons through logical analysis and critical thinking.

We spend about 6½ hours per day 6 days per week basically year round (plus physical education and extra-curricular activities) for a total of about 1700 hrs/yr with 1200 hrs being academic studies. Generally academics were covered 9am-2pm, an extended family sit down main meal, a couple of hours of outdoor activities, field trips, and playtime in the afternoon, reading and (mostly educational) games/videos in the evening. However we try to stay flexible working in some "down days", visits with family, and plenty of travel.

Our daily schedule sheets (three-page chart at the end of this document) are typically over-loaded so it often takes three weeks to complete the two main sheets. The fourth week of the month is a STAFA week focusing only on Science, Theatre Arts, and Fine Arts.
